



2019 UNIFORM POLICY

RATIONALE

The purpose of this Uniform Policy is to provide students, parents, and staff with the specific requirements of the College uniform across our different year levels. It is the responsibility of parents to provide a uniform for their child.

THE WHY FACTOR

Our uniform is an important part of our College identity. We all represent the College community, students and staff, and as ambassadors of Caloundra Christian College, the way we conduct ourselves and dress speaks to who we are and the standards we hold. Wearing the College uniform correctly also helps us to develop habits needed in life.

Throughout our lives there may be many different situations where we will be required to dress to a standard. This may involve a career where uniforms are expected or a safety dress code required for work. Wearing the College uniform appropriately demonstrates a deeper level of social skills like self-control, resilience and an ability to follow directives and also eliminates the fashion-related peer pressure that can occur amongst children and teenagers.

ALL OR NOTHING

When coming to school or leaving school or going anywhere in your uniform, you are representing Caloundra Christian College and therefore you need to wear it fully to the standard outlined below. Wearing only part of the uniform or wearing it incorrectly is not allowed.

ALL IN UNIFORM ALL THE TIME

- The College maintains a policy of correct uniform worn by all students all the time. Teachers will carry out regular uniform checks and, if they are found to be wearing an incorrect aspect of the uniform, they will be sent to the RTC immediately to have the uniform corrected
- Where possible, the uniform may be corrected by the College providing the required item for loan
- If items are not returned, the cost may be charged to the parent
- If the required uniform is not available to borrow, the College may provide the following three options:
 - The item is purchased from the uniform shop by the student;
 - The correct uniform is brought to school by a parent/carer for the student to change into; or
 - The student is sent home until correctly dressed in College uniform.

If our records show a student has borrowed items of clothing numerous times, parents will be contacted to discuss the College expectations. It is a condition of enrolment that students adhere to the uniform policy.

LABEL IT

Students and parents/carers are strongly advised to name all items of the College and sports uniform.

COLLEGE UNIFORM POLICY

PERSONAL JEWELLERY

- Primary girls are allowed one small, plain sleeper or one small, plain, round stud in the lower lobe of each ear only.
- Secondary girls are allowed a maximum of two small, plain, round studs and/or small, plain sleepers in the lower lobe of each ear only.
- Students with multiple ear piercings may wear clear spacesavers if needed.
- Facial piercings and piercings within the mouth are not permitted.
- Students are allowed one small plain ring and a watch.
- Students should not wear bracelets, bangles, and visible necklaces.



COSMETICS

- No make up with the exception of a light foundation, if needed.
- No false eyelashes.
- No coloured or artificial nails.

HAIR

- Hair is to be worn clean, neatly brushed, and kept out of the eyes and off the face throughout the day.
- Extreme and attention seeking hairstyles are not permitted.
- Student hair that is shoulder length is to be fully and neatly tied back and not hanging loosely.
- Basic thin hair ties may be black, white, College navy, or College red.
- Girls' accessories such as scrunchies and ribbons should be in the College colours. Clips and headbands are to be kept to only what is required to keep hair out of the face.
- Boys' facial hair should be minimal and neatly trimmed at all times.
- Principal's discretion will apply to hairstyles.
- Primary students should not have any artificial colour changes to their hair.
- In Secondary, artificial colouring of hair must look natural to the person. Extreme colouring or two-tone colouring is not allowed.

SHOES

Fashion shoes, skate shoes, tennis shoes, boots, and casual shoes are not to be worn with the College sport nor the formal uniform.

Formal Shoes

- Traditional black leather (or similar), lace up, polishable school shoes are to be worn.
- Shoes should be kept clean and in good repair.

Sport Shoes

Sport shoes, which provide ankle and arch support, are to be worn with the sport uniform.

JUMPERS AND SPORTS JACKETS

Primary students are required to wear a jumper with their formal uniform and the sports jacket with their sports uniform. Secondary students may wear either the jumper or the sports jacket with both the formal and sports uniform.

HAT

- Primary students must have a hat with them at all times when out of the classroom.
- Secondary Students are to wear their College hats when doing an activity or in the sun or spending time in the sun.

SCARVES

Students may wear a plain navy blue or red scarf.

GENERAL APPEARANCE

- Boys' shorts are designed to sit above the hip. No underwear should be seen.
- Girls' skirts are designed to sit on the waist. The length should be no higher than the top of the knee.
- Noticeable coloured undergarments or coloured clothing items are not to be worn under uniforms.

STUDENT BAGS

- School bags are compulsory for all students.
- School bags must not be defaced, and any additions must be consistent with the College ethos.
- School bags are to be left in bag racks or lockers and are not carried to classes.
- Satchels and bags specifically designed for laptops or devices should be small and plain.

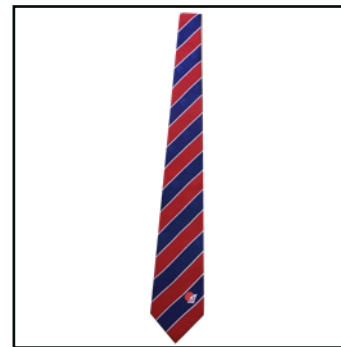
